



## God's Supernatural Supply In Your Finances Text: Psalm 1

- We can see supernatural supply throughout the Bible.
- It's not about what you have because God can take what you have and multiply it!
- Sometimes WE BLOCK OUR OWN blessings by:
  - what we think.
  - what we say.
  - our lack of giving.
  - our limited vision.
- There comes a time when YOU have to DO something or YOU HAVE TO CHANGE something in order to receive your supernatural supply.

## How Do You Open Up Your Supernatural Supply? What Do You Need To Dig Out?

- 1. GET RID OF WRONG THINKING.
  - Poverty is a MINDSET and you have to dig it out!
  - Thinking you have to be poor like your family will get you nowhere.
  - Thinking that GIVING does not make a difference will get you nowhere.
  - Thinking that you are limited by your income will get you nowhere.
  - Let go of poverty thoughts and start believing God's Word instead.
  - Whatever you put up with is exactly what you will have. Don't put up with it anymore!
- 2. OBEY GOD IN YOUR GIVING. II Corinthians 8:7
  - Be faithful with what you have no matter how small or large. Matthew 25:21
  - <u>Three types of giving in the Bible</u>:
    - Tithe: Malachi 3:6-12
    - Offerings: II Corinthians 9:6-11
    - Giving to the Needy: Proverbs 19:17, 28:27
  - You can't afford NOT to tithe. Malachi 3:10-12, Proverbs 11:24-25 (New Living)
  - The tithe is the Lord's and it is holy unto Him. Leviticus 27:30, Malachi 3:6-12
  - When you release what belongs to God—He will release what belongs to you! Galatians 6:7
- 3. SPEAK BLESSINGS OVER YOUR FINANCES.
  - Don't SABOTAGE YOUR FINANCES with your own words. Proverbs 24:3-4
  - Your faith is not just for times of crisis. It's for everyday living. God is concerned about every area of your life.
  - Take your blinders off when it comes to God meeting your needs and shifting your financial situation!
  - You have to stop talking poverty and lack—and complaining about what you don't have. Instead, put your faith out there for supernatural financial blessings!
- 4. WRITE YOUR VISION AND PRAY FOR GOD'S WISDOM AND DIRECTION.
  - You need a budget to follow and goals to work toward. Proverbs 29:18
