

# 1 Timothy 6 Lisa Osteen Comes

#### I. SLAVERY, THE WORKPLACE, AND EXCELLENCE: (VERSES 1-2)

- There was a specific reason Paul needed to address slavery.
- It was essential that both Christian slaves and masters recognized that they were on **equal terms** as believers.
- Paul reminded the Christian slaves and masters to be a godly example by the way they treated one another.
- We should work with excellence and show respect for our leadership—because it is a reflection on the God we serve.

#### **II. AVOID FALSE TEACHING: (VERSES 3-5)**

- Don't allow anyone to pull you away from the sound teaching of the Bible.
- Don't let anyone talk you into compromising God's Word and commands.
- Don't let anyone tell you that they have **special revelation** that no one else has.
- If a person tries to pull you out of the local church that is a sure sign that something is wrong.
- God called us to unity, and He does not give anyone special revelation that contradicts His Word or pulls people away from God or the local church.


#### **FALSE TEACHING IN THE CULTURE OF THE DAY:**

- Gnostism: many beliefs contrary to the teachings of Jesus. One belief was that God was unknowable.
- 2. **Decadent Judaism:** imposed Old Testament practices on the New Testament believers.
- 3. False Asceticism: a teaching that believed the physical body should be treated harshly.

#### **CHARACTERISTICS OF FALSE MINISTERS:**

- 1. Deceivers.
- 2. Proud and conceited.

- 4. Stir up strife and envy.
- 5. Malicious talkers.
- 6. Evil suspicions.
- 7. Greedy.

### III. MONEY: CONTENTMENT, GREED, AND WEALTHY BELIEVERS (VERSES 6-10)

### A. The value of contentment: Philippians 4:11-13, Matthew 6:33

- Content is a state of peaceful happiness; being satisfied; cheerful; and restful.
- It's an attitude of the heart.
- We should be content and grateful no matter our state or circumstances.

#### B. Greed: Colossians 3:1-3

- Greed is an obsession over money.
- True contentment comes from knowing God.
- Greed is the intense and selfish desire for something especially wealth, power, or food.

### C. Instructions to wealthy believers: (VERSES 17-19)


## 2 dangers for the wealthy to avoid:

- Arrogance
- Dependence on money

#### 5 instructions to wealthy believers:

- 1. Go after God. Always seek Him and don't be obsessed with money.
- 2. Don't be arrogant because you have wealth. Keep a humble attitude because wealth is uncertain, but God is your true Source of riches.
- 3. Be rich in helping others. Do good works to and for others. Having wealth does not exclude you from doing acts of service and generosity.
- 4. Be extravagantly generous. Be liberal and share your blessings with others who have needs because YOU are blessed to be a blessing. Use your wealth in a positive way.
- 5. When you do these things, you are storing up treasures in Heaven.





## IV. CHARGE TO TIMOTHY: PURSUE, FIGHT, GUARD: (VERSES 11-16)

## A. Pursue these 6 things:

- 1. Righteousness: right living in God's eyes.
- 2. Godliness
- 3. Faith
- 4. Love
- 5. Endurance
- 6. Gentleness

## B. Fight the good fight of faith: 1John 5:4

- · Sometimes circumstances seem against us.
- There are times people will oppose us and mistreat us.
- Satan is our enemy and he will seek to oppose and stop us.

## C. Guard the deposit in you:

- Paul expressed 7 statements of majestic praise to God:
  - 1. Blessed and only Ruler
  - 2. King of kings
  - 3. Lord of lords
  - 4. Immortal God
  - 5. Deserves all honor
  - 6. Deserves all power
  - 7. Deserves all might
