The Bible teaches that there are 2 kingdoms:

- 1. The Kingdom of Light:
 - When we accept Jesus, we are rescued from Satan's power and brought into His kingdom. Luke 10:18, I Corinthians 4:20
 - His Kingdom is the Kingdom of light, healing, peace, and joy.
- 2. The Kingdom of Darkness
 - The work and attacks of Satan.
 - You don't have to fear the enemy the enemy fears you! John 14:30, Matthew 12:28, Matthew 16:19, James 4:7

The Kingdom of God is a kingdom of power where miracles and healing are natural:

I Corinthians 4:20

1. We can learn about what this kingdom is like from Jesus' teaching in the Gospels.

Jesus' life was marked by healings, miracles, and power over Satan: Acts 2:22

- 1. Jesus stood up in the synagogue and proclaimed His purpose. Luke 4:17-19
- 2. God anoints Jesus with the Holy Spirit and power. Acts 10:38
- 3. Jesus goes throughout Galilee teaching. Matthew 4:23
 - Jesus majored on 3 things in His life:
 - Teaching the Word
 - Preaching the Good News of the Kingdom
- 4. In the New Testament, 3 words refer to miracles:
 - Healing the Sick. Power (Greek/dynamis): mighty deed
 - Wonder (Greek/teras): something extraordinary
 - Sign (Greek/semeion): miracle that displays God's glory and power
- 5. There are 37-recorded Miracles of Jesus:
 - 8 Miraculous Signs
 - 6 Miraculous deliverances from demons
 - 23 Miraculous physical healings

Jesus sent His disciples out and commissioned them to do the works He did: Luke 9:2, 10:9

- 1. Jesus gave His disciples power and authority to drive out all demons and to heal the sick.
 - They found that they could walk in the same anointing that Jesus did and that they had power over the enemy.



After Jesus ascends into Heaven, the apostles and disciples continued to follow Jesus' example and their lives were marked by healing and miracles: Acts 2:38-39

- 1. Healings and miracles are our inheritance!
- 2. The Kingdom of God is a Kingdom of power where it is natural to see the supernatural.

Jesus gave each one us power to use His Name to heal the sick and cast out demons:

Mark 16:16-18

- 1. Jesus gave you the right and authority to act on His behalf.
- 2. When you pray for someone in the Name of Jesus it's as if Jesus Himself did it!
- 3. We are to do the praying and He does the healing and miracles.

Believers should expect to experience the supernatural and be conduits of God's power to bring healing and freedom to others: II Corinthians 5:20

- 1. We should allow the compassion of Jesus to flow through us to other people.
- 2. Prayer is to flow through us!
- 3. We are ambassadors for Christ!
- 4. God has places for you to be and people for you to help!

What Does the Bible Teach About Healing?

- 1. God reveals Himself to His people as the One who heals. Malachi 4:2
- 2. Jesus bore our sickness on the Cross. Isaiah 53:4-5. Psalm 103:2-5
- 3. Accept healing as your spiritual inheritance! I Corinthians 6:19-20
- 4. Don't limit God or try to put God in a box when it comes to healing.
- **5. We have been commissioned by God to pray for the sick.** Matthew 10:8, James 5:14-15, Mark 16:15-17
