The God Who Rescues Text: Psalm 55

- God's thoughts will never trouble your mind. John 8:44
- The Word of God will bring PEACE and JOY even though you may be troubled on every side.
- GOD will rescue us. Psalm 55:18
- We will go through hardships and setbacks. Psalm 34:19
- Rescue: to save someone from a dangerous or distressing situation—to recover and deliver.
- We are marked by the BLOOD OF JESUS.
- We are protected by the BLOOD OF THE LAMB.
- When the enemy comes to kill, steal and destroy—he sees the BLOOD OF JESUS—and he cannot cross the BLOODLINE!
- Hold on to God's Word like never before!
- Keep obeying God and when God rescues you—you will not look like what you have been through!

Takeaways:

- 1. Let's refuse to compromise under pressure.
- 2. Let's refuse to give up when we are in the middle of the process.
 - It is through FAITH AND PATIENCE that you receive the promises of God. Hebrews 6:12, James 1:1-4
 - If you refuse to give up—you will come out of the trial a different person—stronger, more mature, and with an unshakable confidence in God.
- 3. Let's refuse to blame God.
 - Instead, seek Him with all your heart.
 - God is not your problem—He is your SOLUTION. Jeremiah 33:3
- 4. Let's refuse to get bitter or take on the victim mentality.
- 5. Let's refuse to allow fear and anxiety to torment us and control our life.
 - If you struggle with this, meditate on God's Word day and night.
 - What you meditate on determines YOUR ATTITUDE AND YOUR ALTITUDE. Isaiah 41:10, Psalm 27:1
