John 4

1. JOHN EMPHASIZED WATER BAPTISM: JOHN 4:1-2

- Jesus was baptized by John the Baptist, the Day of Pentecost continues the baptism of disciples, and before leaving earth Jesus commanded all believers to be water baptized.
- Water baptism is one of the first actions every new believer should take.
- Water baptism represents what Jesus did for us in salvation it symbolizes leaving our old lives and becoming a new creature in Christ Jesus.

2. JESUS NEEDED TO GO THROUGH SAMASRIA ON HIS WAY TO GALILEE: JOHN 4:4

- Jews would avoid going through the city of Samaria on the way to Galilee because they did not like each other.
- Jesus needed to go through Samaria because there were people who needed Him there
- There is so much rich Jewish history here, and yet, the people in Samaria had strayed from God. That's why Jesus NEEDED to go to Samaria.


3. THE WOMAN WHOM JESUS LOVED: JOHN 4:4-42

- The woman's past reputation didn't change how Jesus viewed or valued her.
- Start a conversation with people and get to know them so you will have an open door to share the Gospel with them—like Jesus did.
- In God's eyes, no one is too far-gone or considered an outcast. He has a purpose and a plan for each of us.

4. WE MUST WORSHIP GOD IN SPIRIT AND IN TRUTH: JOHN 4:19-38

It is not about the location, but about the attitude of the heart.

- Worship God from your spirit with an attitude of reverence, awe, and gratefulness. Worship Him in truth, knowing who He is and what He has done for you.
- This is a daily lifestyle—not something we do ONLY in church.
- One thing we are all created to do is be an ambassador for the Lord Jesus. To let our light shine and point people to Him.
- Jesus used the idea of food and harvest to communicate a spiritual truth to us. The
 idea of harvest meant that there were many people ready to receive Jesus—and WE
 should see ourselves as workers—or reapers—in that harvest.

5. JESUS HEALS THE ROYAL OFFICIAL'S SON: JOHN 4:43-454

- This man had a promise from God and he took Jesus at His Word. That is called faith.
- There are thousands of promises in God's Word for YOU! Search the Scriptures and know that YOU can TAKE Jesus at His Word just like this man!
