



Facing The Future Without Fear A Bible Timeline of Events

Bible Timeline:

1. **Innocence in the Garden of Eden.** Genesis 2
 - **Why is it that we always want what we cannot have?** Genesis 2:15-17
 - **The Age of Innocence ended with The Fall of Man.**
 - **From the moment man fell, God devised a plan to redeem us and restore us to Himself.**
2. **The Age of Conscience**
 - **When Adam and Eve sinned, they passed down to every human the knowledge of good and evil.**
 - **For a long time, there was no law and people would distinguish between good and evil by listening to their voice of conscience.**
3. **The Giving of the Law**
 - **God gave Moses the Ten Commandments on Mount Sinai—to define righteousness and sin in the eyes of the people.** Exodus 20-40
 - **God set up the Priesthood so that the Priests could represent the people in the presence of God and offer sacrifices for their sins.**
 - **Eventually, God chose Kings and Prophets to rule, and in that day, God only spoke THROUGH the Priest, the King, or the Prophets.**
4. **The Age of Grace or The Church Age**
 - **This is the day we are living in now.**
 - **Because of the work of Jesus on the Cross, every person can have a personal relationship with God.**
 - **No person or minister has to represent you IN the presence of God.** I Timothy 2:5
 - **Jesus took care of the sin problem once and for all—and today, we freely receive God's forgiveness, mercy, and grace!** Hebrews 4:16
 - **Today, we are empowered by the Holy Spirit to be overcomers—and to fulfill God's work on the earth.** II Corinthians 12:9
 - **It's by grace we are saved and by grace that we live for Jesus!** Ephesians 2:8
5. **The Tribulation:** Matthew 24:15-31, Daniel 9:24-27, Matthew 24:11
 - A. **The Lawlessness One will be revealed.** II Thessalonians 2:3-12
 - **The man of lawlessness is the Antichrist, also referred to as the Beast.**
 - B. **There will be all kinds of disasters and demonic attacks.** Revelation 6-9
 - C. **There will be a Remnant Church that will turn to Jesus during the Tribulation.** Revelation 7
 - D. **God will send His two Witnesses who will preach the Gospel for three and a half years from Jerusalem.** Revelation 11:1-14
 - E. **The Tribulation will end with the Battle of Armageddon.** Revelation 16:16, Isaiah 10:28-34, Joel 2
 - F. **The Marriage Supper of the Lamb.** Revelation 19:6-9
 - **The Bible refers to Jesus as the Groom and we, the Church, as His Bride.**
 - **During the Tribulation, we will be in Heaven celebrating with Jesus at the Marriage Supper of the Lamb.** Matthew 26:29



- G. **Jesus will capture the Antichrist and his False Prophet—and He will throw them into the Lake of Fire.**
- H. **Jesus will capture Satan and chain him to the bottomless pit for a thousand years and his demons will be expelled from the earth.** Isaiah 24:21-22, Matthew 13:41-43, Matthew 25:31-46, Revelation 19:20-21, Revelation 20:1-3
- 6. **The Millennial Reign:** Revelation 20
 - A. **During this time, we will rule with Jesus on the earth.**
 - B. **At the end of the one thousand years, Satan will be released to roam the earth one last time.**
 - C. **God throws Satan into the Lake of Fire—where he will spend eternity.**
 - D. **Death and the grave are cast into the Lake of Fire forever!** Revelation 20:14-15
- 7. **Perfection in Eternity:** Revelation 21
 - **We will spend eternity with Jesus in a new Heaven and a new Earth!** Isaiah 65:17
