# **II Corinthians 6**

### **THREE MAIN TOPICS OF II CORINTHIANS 6:**

- 1. We are co-workers with God.
- 2. What a Godly life looks like.
- 3. Being unequally yoked with unbelievers.

## WE ARE CO-WORKERS WITH GOD: (II Cor. 6:1-2)

- 1. Paul sees himself as God's co-worker and this is how God sees us.
  - We are partners together with God doing His work. (I Cor. 3:9)
  - This is not our ministry, but God's ministry.
  - We are not only called to serve Jesus, but to represent Him wherever we go. (II Cor. 5:20)
  - God wants to lead you and work through you!
- 2. Paul urged us not to receive God's grace in vain.
  - Today is the day of salvation and it is only through Jesus that we are saved and made righteous before God. (Eph. 2:8-9)

#### WHAT A GODLY LIFE LOOKS LIKE: (II Cor. 3-13)

- 1. Paul tells us what a godly life looks like:
  - We patiently endure hardship.
  - We maintain a pure heart.
  - We are understanding with people.

- We are patient with people.
- We are kind to people.
- We sincerely love people.
- We have the Holy Spirit.
- We faithfully preach the Truth of the Gospel of Jesus.
- God's power is working in us.
- We use the weapons God has given us.
- We serve God whether people honor us or despise us.
- We are honest and have spoken honestly.
- We have joy even though our hearts ache.
- 2. We don't live like the world.
- 3. We can pray and God will turn situations around. We have been given authority over Satan in the Name of Jesus.

#### DO NOT BE UNEQUALLY YOKED WITH UNBELIEVERS: (II COR. 6:14-18)

- 1. Yoke means to join or couple together. It's the literal meaning of being balanced.
  - We as believers must remain stable and balanced in our Christian walk.
  - We cannot do this is we are unequally yoked with the wrong people.
- 2. The Bible teaches us that believers and unbelievers live in 2 different worlds.
  - The kingdom of darkness is Satan's kingdom and the Kingdom of Light is God's Kingdom. (Col. 1:13-14)
  - In God's Kingdom, there is righteousness, peace, and joy in the Holy Spirit. (Romans 4:17)
  - When you are unequally yoked with unbelievers, you are yoking yourself with darkness. (Eph. 5:8-10)
  - We are to separate ourselves from unbelievers in the sense of being yoked with them in marriage, relationships, or in business.
- 3. The good news is that Jesus wants to be yoked together with you!



- We have the privilege of being in an intimate relationship with Jesus walking together with Him step by step.
- This is also a reminder that we are not alone in life.
- We are yoked with the One who gives us the strength and direction we need.
