



**Dream Big For Your Finances**  
**Part II – Keys To Financial Blessings**

1. We must **GIVE** God what **BELONGS** to Him. Malachi 3:8-12, Leviticus 27:30

**Five Spiritual Transactions That Take Place When You Tithe:**

- A. God removes the curse of poverty and lack from your life.
- The first 10% of your income **BELONGS** to God. It is the basis for financial freedom and blessings.
- B. When you tithe, you become partners with God in **Kingdom** work. II Corinthians 6:1
- When you give, you are supporting the work of God and the local church that blesses you and your family. You are helping spread the Good News about Jesus all over the world. You are helping the poor and needy.
  - When you give, God will multiply the 90% that you have left over!
  - When you release what belongs to God—He will release what belongs to you!
- C. God opens the windows of Heaven over your life.
- Tithing opens the door to Heaven’s blessings.
- D. God rebukes the devourer over your finances.
- The enemy may come in to try to steal from you—but God rebukes the devourer for **YOUR SAKE!**
- E. People will call you blessed!

**John Osteen’s Words Of Wisdom Concerning Finances:**

- A. The tithe is not 10% of your income, but the **FIRST** 10%.
- To unlock the blessings of God you must give Him the first 10%. God wants to be **FIRST** in your life—and you must honor God with your money.
- B. When you give God the first tenth, you can always afford to tithe.
- You may say, I can’t afford to tithe, but really you can’t afford not to tithe.
- C. You cannot rob God and please him at the same time.
- D. God gave the laws of giving **FOR US**.
- E. There are laws that God has placed in the earth, and the law of **SEEDTIME AND HARVEST** is one of them. Genesis 8:22, Galatians 6:9, Proverbs 11:25
- Whatever you sow—you will reap.
- F. We don’t have to pray about some things because God commanded us to do them.
- G. We rob God of the joy of blessing us as His children when we do not obey Him.
- H. You didn’t get into your financial mess overnight so it’s going to take sacrifice and time to get out of it.
- I. God wants to bless us financially, but He has a hard time when we spend money we don’t have.
- J. Don’t wait until you get out of your financial mess to start honoring God—start now by giving your tithe to the Lord.
2. Have a vision for your finances and set goals to accomplish it. Proverbs 29:18, Habakkuk 2:2, Proverbs 21:5
