Three Of The Most Common Ways We Can Hear God's Voice:

- 1. God speaks to us through His Word. II Timothy 3:16 NLT, Psalm 119:105; I John 1:9, Proverbs 10:22, Ephesians 1:17-19 NLT
 - The Bible contains the words of God. It is the voice of God speaking into our lives. It is God breathed! It teaches us how to live a life that is pleasing to God.
 - Every time you read the Bible, God is speaking to you and revealing Himself to you.
 - The Bible CONTAINS the thoughts of God, the wisdom of God, and the commands of God.
 - The Bible is our Christian Manual.
 - The Bible is a love letter from God to you!
- 2. God speaks to your spirit. John 16:13-14, Proverbs 20:27, I Kings 19:12
 - God does not speak to your mind, but to your spirit.
 - God is a Spirit and He speaks to us in our spirit, where the Holy Spirit lives.
- 3. God speaks to us through the presence of His PEACE in our spirit. Colossians 3:15, Proverbs 19:2
 - Jesus is the Prince of Peace and His voice is a voice of PEACE.
 - When God approves of something, you will sense His PEACE or inner calm in your spirit.
 - A LACK OF PEACE in your spirit is a NO or a NOT NOW.
 - Understanding What God's Voice Sounds Like:
 - The Holy Spirit stills you. Satan rushes you.
 - The Holy Spirit leads you. Satan pushes you.
 - The Holy Sprit reassures you. Satan frightens you.
 - The Holy Spirit enlightens you. Satan confuses you.
 - The Holy Spirit calms you. Satan upsets you.
 - Head in the direction that gives you the most peace.
