



Four Things Jesus Died To Give You Text: Luke 4:17-19

These are four things that belong to you—whether you receive them or not. They are your inheritance from Jesus. He left them for you in His WILL.

- 1. Jesus died to bring the Good News to you! Romans 1:16, John 16:33, Isaiah 53:4-5, Matthew 11:28-30
 - Jesus died so that you can really live.
 - Jesus bore your sins so that you could receive forgiveness, mercy, and release from guilt.
 - Jesus is your Burden Bearer.
 - Jesus desires a personal relationship with you.
- 2. Jesus died to give you freedom from anything that imprisons you. Isaiah 61:1-3, 7, Matthew 11:28
 - Jesus came to heal the broken and give freedom to the oppressed.
 - Freedom is your inheritance! Freedom can come instantly or through a process.
 - Good things happen in the process. There's growth and healing in the process.
- 3. Jesus died to give you physical healing. Isaiah 53:5, Jeremiah 30:19
 - Jesus is our healer. He not only carried our sins, but he also carried our sicknesses and diseases.
 - Healing can come instantly or through a process.
- **4. Jesus died to give you His favor in abundance!** Luke 4:19, Psalm 23:6, James 3:10, Psalm 84:11, Psalm 5:12, Psalm 30:5, Proverbs 16:15, Proverbs 3:33-35
 - Jesus loves you and desires to bless you with His kindness and favor.
 - Favor is God's goodness in your life.
 - Favor is having God's blessing upon your life.
 - Favor in Hebrew translates as goodwill, acceptance, delight and to have pleasure.
 - Expect the favor of God in your life.
